

Citizens Advisory Board — Weir River Water System
Meeting Minutes January 28, 2026 | Water Commissioners Meeting 6:01 PM

I. Call to Order

The CAB attended the regular meeting of the Board of Water Commissioners on January 28, 2026. Attending the meeting were members: Chuck Culpin, Brian McCarthy, John Struzziery, Jim Broderick, and Dave Anderson.

II. CAB Report to the Board of Water Commissioners

Chair Anderson addressed the Board of Water Commissioners and reported that the Citizens Advisory Board had reviewed the proposed rate schedule and voted unanimously to recommend it to the Board of Water Commissioners as part of the rate-setting process.

Chair Anderson offered the following rationale in support of the CAB's recommendation:

- Operating costs for the system have risen, and the system has important capital needs that must be addressed
- The proposed rates are intended to keep the system reliable and compliant while funding planned capital investments, including the new Hull storage tank and booster station and the rehabilitation of the Turkey Hill tank
- The proposed rate increases are consistent with the models developed at the time of the water system's acquisition

After further discussion, the Water Commissioners approved the proposed rate increases.

III. Adjournment

There being no further business before the CAB, CAB's participation in the Water Commissioners meeting concluded and the meeting was adjourned.
